As part of the Community Connected project, we have a limited number of refurbished computers (and networking equipment, such as PCMCIA cards, WIC cards, USB adaptors, etc) to supply to residents on the Cambridge Road Estate and Cambridge Gardens on long-term loan.



How to APPLY FOR a free personal computer from PC+

The Community Connected project has been funded to provide access to training and learning to people 1) on no/low income and 2) to people with no experience of using the Internet at home.

We will have to concentrate our limited resources on those in the greatest need. Inevitably, demand will exceed supply so there will be a waiting list for refurbished computers.

How to APPLY FOR free networking equipment from PC+

If you already have a computer at home, you can apply for free networking equipment to enable you to 'get online'. Any equipment will be supplied to you on long-term loan.

All refurbished computers supplied on loan by Community Connected will be enabled to work with the free wireless broadband Internet access. If you receive a free refurbished computer from Community Connected you do not need to apply for (additional) networking equipment.



How to EARN a free personal computer from PC+

We're looking for people on the CRE to help us refurbish donated PCs.

Help us refurbish say 4 or 5, and you get higher priority for taking one home. You may already have some PC skills, or you may be looking to develop those skills. You may be happy to come along and help your neighbours; you may be looking to add something special to your CV.
